WINTER TRAVEL 15

These courses focus on the experiential learning and best practices for Winter Travel in mountain environments with an overarching goal of **YOUTH ENGAGEMENT** in **STEWARDSHIP**.

Course Dates: Feb 25-28 and March 11-14



PURPOSE

To encourage youth to engage in winter travel and recreation in mountain environments as informed and aware individuals through downhill snowsports (skiing and snowboarding), cross country skiing and snowshoeing.

LOCATION

Canadian Rockies Outdoor Learning Centre has partnered with Lake Louise Ski Hill for on site learning with Lake Louise Ski Instructors, Ski Patrol, and Avalanche Team and Parks Canada Staff. Students will also XC ski and snowshoe throughout Banff National Park and Yoho National Park. Students will stay at the Great Divide Lodge.

DELIVERY


Pre-Immersion and Post-Immersion sessions at the students home school delivered by the classroom teacher OR distributed learning with Outdoor Learning Centre staff. Critical thinking project based inquiry will foster student engagement. Immersion in a 4 day residential program at the Canadian Rockies Outdoor Learning Centre at Lake Louise within Banff National Park which operates under a comprehensive public safety system ensuring the highest standards of due diligence and of care. The emphasis here is placed on active learning. Students should be comfortable skiing on a GREEN level run.

ACTIVITIES & INSIGHTS

Avalanche awareness, trip planning, GPS, navigation, emergency scenarios, outdoor resume building and career exploration, team building and leadership skills. Earns 3 high school credits!
