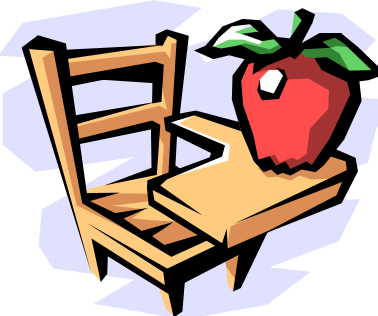

Food for Learning Program



What is the Food for Learning Program?

The Food for Learning program was started at Elizabeth Rummel School in the fall of 2001 with Banff Elementary following in 2005. This was in response to concerns raised by staff that a number of the students were regularly arriving at school hungry and with inadequate lunches. The purpose of the program is to provide a daily nutritious lunch for students who participate in the program.

Families refer their children to the program. There are no criteria to qualify. All referrals are accepted.

We have noticed that students who receive the lunches appear happier and healthier. In many cases, attendance at school improves once the child begins the Food for Learning program. Teachers have reported changes in behavior for children who were experiencing difficulty socializing with their peers. These students are more able to concentrate.

The cost for the program is about \$900/student for the year. The success of the program depends entirely on the generosity and support of individuals, local businesses and community groups.

We are excited to bring this program to the Banff Community High School for the 2011-2012 school year.

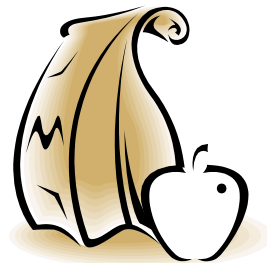
The Food for Learning
