#### **COVID INFORMATION**

Note: our AP 413 COVID-19 HARM REDUCTION procedure is now in place. The purpose of this administrative procedure is to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 infection in all Division facilities. This procedure will protect staff, students, and their families from a highly contagious illness during the global pandemic.

This procedure applies to all employees and School Board Trustees of CRSD. It also applies to all persons carrying out duties, or activities on Division property and volunteers of the Division. Any new employees, contractors, guests, and volunteers to the Division on or after November 24th, 2021 will require proof of full vaccination or proof of rapid testing for COVID-19 as a condition of employment or volunteering except as specifically exempted in the AP.

We continue to follow the directives outlined by <u>Alberta Health Services</u> and the Canadian Rockies <u>Reentry plan</u> for 2021/22. Please be certain to do regular student screening using the <u>Updated COVID checklist</u>. A reminder to families as per our CRPS reentry plan - "If a student

presents with COVID-19 symptoms during the school day, as per the Alberta Health Daily Checklist and as determined by school staff, parents must be contacted immediately to pick up their child."
