Wim and Nancy Pauw Wilderness Experience

On Monday and Tuesday of this week our grade 10 students participated in cross country skiing through the support of the Wim and Nancy Pauw Wilderness Experience. This program aims to get all of our students outdoor experience and learning about our landscape. Students in grade 10 have participated in hikes in the fall, avalanche awareness earlier this winter, and will participate in snowshoeing and viking boating in the spring.

COVID Information

This week the government of Alberta announced that public health measures will be phased out in 3 steps. On Thursday, February 10, Canadian Rockies Public School shared a <u>letter</u> that outlines our updated protocols. For further details, please see the <u>CRPS reentry plan</u>.

Beginning on Monday, February 14, 2022, all school mandatory masking requirements for students will be removed. While mask mandates have been removed, students may elect to continue wearing masks at their own discretion.


Staff in the school will continue to wear masks unless they are socially distanced and cohorted with their classrooms.

Other protocol changes:

- Sports will resume with team travel allowed
- Spectators are welcome to watch games. There will be limited seating at school events. All guests must wear masks.
- We will continue to limit movement in the building:
 - Doors will be open from 8:00 8:30 am and 1:45 2:00 pm
- Purkis Hall remains closed
- No gym use at lunch
- Closed Campus continues:
 - Students still eat in their block 3 class
 - Students may leave school for lunch but will only be allowed back in the building at 1:45 pm
 - No volunteers/guest speakers in the school only essential service providers
- Visitors will enter the school by appointment only. All visitors will require masks
- We will continue to promote physical distancing where possible.
- Students are expected to continue to follow the <u>COVID-19 Alberta Health Daily</u> <u>Checklist</u> to determine when to stay home from school

Family Week / Teacher Professional Learning

As a reminder, there is no school for students between Monday, February 21 and Friday, February 25. Monday, February 21, 2022 is Family Day, with system closures on the 22nd and 23rd. On Thursday, February 24th and 25th, teachers will be participating in professional development online at the Alberta Teacher Convention. This year teachers will attend sessions on topics that include traditional knowledge keepers, differentiation in the classroom, assessment practices, and subject-specific pedagogy. Keynote speakers this year at the Teacher Convention include Dr. Robyne Hanley-Dafoe - discussing Wellness, Sarah Watson and Michael Ungar discussing resilience, and Lindsey Fagan and Michaelle Good discussing the impact of Residential Schools.
