Lockdown Drill Thursday, November 24 at 2 pm

The health and safety of all children at BCHS is paramount. One of our responsibilities in regard to safety is to run an annual lockdown drill.

The purpose of the drill is to practice how we can protect everyone from harm when a danger is present inside the school. Students will review what to do, including "Safe, Silent & Serious", with their teachers in advance.

We recognize that the mention of the word "lockdown" raises questions and concerns. We invite you to have a conversation at home with your child to be proactive and teachers will certainly engage in these conversations at school too.

While incidents requiring an emergency response in our school are very, very rare, "lockdown" drills are a part of our emergency response practices, similar to fire drills. In this way, we hope everyone will feel more confident, less anxious and better able to cope knowing there is a plan and procedures in place for a situation of this kind.
