Career and Post Secondary Education Prep at BCHS

This week we have two events for our students that help them think about and begin to prepare for their post high school plans. Our Grade 11 and 12 students already visited the 'Out of Province Fair' at CCHS in October plus had the opportunity to attend Open Houses at SAIT and Olds College. On Monday BCHS hosts **15 post secondary education institutions and career recruiters** with the Educational Liaison Association of Alberta (ELAA). Parents are welcome to attend between 9 - 11 am and Grade 10 to 12 students will all have an opportunity to find out more from our Alberta visitors.

On Tuesday, November 29 at 2 pm Grade 9 and 10 students will participate in a presentation called **'Working it Out'** from Alberta Workers Health Centre. During the presentation there is a play which demonstrates to our young people the dangers of the workplace and encourages them to understand their rights as a worker. This will kick start the **Grade 9 Work Study** program planned for January 2023 and help Grade 10 get ready for the Work Experience 15-25-35 course they may wish to enroll in, in addition to supporting them to be safe workers.
