Planning for 2023/24 and Transition News

The process of course selection is now complete - thank you. The next step for the CRPS high school administration team is to create a schedule based on staffing and student requests. This process will take over a month to complete and our intent is to have schedules out to students in June for any final tweaking. The Grade 8s from Banff Elementary School will be visiting on Thursday, April 23 as part of their transition to high school and our Grade 11 student leaders will help host them.

Diploma Exams, Provincial Assessment Tests, and School Exams

We have had a few questions about dates for the end-of-year exams. Currently, all Grade 12 Diploma exams are scheduled on our school's calendar on our website. These dates are fixed by the province and cannot be changed. Grade 9 Provincial Achievement Test dates are on our website calendar and are also scheduled by the province. School final exams for Grade 10 and 11 courses will occur between June 19 and June 27 and the schedule is being finalized with teachers and will be published soon. If a student cannot take a school exam on the date scheduled there may be a possibility of negotiating with the teacher for an alternative date.
