## Disaster Readiness Day in Banff


**Sunday, May 7 from 12 - 4 pm Banff Train Station - Large Parking Lot**

Families in Banff are invited to a showcase of large emergency vehicles, heavy equipment, trucks, helicopters and rescue tools, and the crews who keep the Bow Valley safe during a major emergency. See how agencies are prepared to deal with disasters – wildfire, flooding, severe storms, wild animal attack – and more.

Children and adults will enjoy demonstrations and access to emergency vehicles while learning how locals can take steps to be prepared for emergencies. Participating agencies include: Banff Fire Rescue, STARS Air Ambulance, Alpine Helicopters, Canmore Fire Rescue, Banff RCMP and K-Division Bomb Techs, Canada Task Force 2, Search and Rescue Alberta, Banff EMS, Parks Canada Wildlife Safety, Emergency Management, and Fire/Vegetation Crew, Roam Transit's e-bus, ATCO, FortisAlberta, AltaLink, and others.
