GRADE 12s - YOU MUST MOVE YOUR DATA before July 31, 2023!

• If you are **applying for post-secondary scholarships**, use a personal email account, not your CRPS email so you can still access your applications. You will need to move your data before you leave BCHS.

Google has tools to help you including:

- **Download** If there are only a few things you want to keep, including items shared with you, <u>download</u> a copy of individual files or folders.
- Forward important emails to another personal email account. Learn more.
- **Transfer your content** copy your Drive and Email files to a personal Google account. Learn <u>more</u>.
- Archive/Takeout download a copy of items owned by you in all G Suite services into one zip file. Learn more.
- **Transfer Ownership** If others will need to use files you own, you can transfer ownership to someone else at CRPS in sharing options, or they can take a copy for themselves. Learn <u>more</u>.

Student Timetables 2023 - 2024

In the event of a student failing a core course at the end of this school year; administration will have to make some changes to that student's schedule as they will not have the prerequisite course to move on to the next level.

Parent Portal and Final Marks

Reminder to students and families that teachers are entering final marks and comments in Parent Portal. Parent Portal remains visible so students and families can see updated marks as students complete final assessments for the year. Remember that comments and marks are not final until June 30.

Diploma Exams, Provincial Assessment Tests, and School Exam Timetable

The June exam timetable is available on our website.

Students are expected to turn up for exams as scheduled. If a student is ill on the morning of an exam parents should call the school as soon as possible. In this situation, **school final exams**

and PATs can be written after the date scheduled. Students will be expected to arrange an alternative date with their teacher in order to pass the course. Diploma exams are fixed and cannot be changed. If a student misses their diploma exam they will need to take the exam in Calgary in August. All students should arrive at 8:45 am for their exam. Students may bring water and snacks that are not noisy to eat. No hats, cell phones, or Smart watches are allowed in the exam room.
