Report Cards

A reminder to parents, you will only have until the end of July to access and download this year's digital version of the report card through the PowerSchool Parent Portal. It is not archived there from year to year and will be unavailable after the end of July.

Student Timetables 2023-2024

A reminder to parents that we have now completed student timetables for the 2023/2024 school year. **Students will not be able to change courses in August.** In the event of a student failing a core course at the end of the year, administration will have to make some changes to that student's schedule as they will not have the prerequisite course to move on to the next level.

Student Reminders

GRADE 12s - YOU **MUST** MOVE YOUR DATA **before July 31, 2023!**

- If you are **applying for post-secondary scholarships**, use a personal email account, not your CRPS email so you can still access your applications. You will need to move your data before you leave BCHS.

Google has tools to help you including:

- **Download** – If there are only a few things you want to keep, including items shared with you, [download](#) a copy of individual files or folders.
- **Forward important emails** to another personal email account. [Learn more.](#)
- **Transfer your content** – copy your Drive and Email files to a personal Google account. Learn [more.](#)
- **Archive/Takeout** - download a copy of items owned by you in all G Suite services into one zip file. Learn [more.](#)
- **Transfer Ownership** - If others will need to use files you own, you can transfer ownership to someone else at CRPS in sharing options, or they can take a copy for themselves. Learn [more.](#)

- The employer will be asked to fill out a Google Form (which will be emailed to them directly).
- A site visit from the Off-campus Experience Coordinator (teacher), will take place and then the student will be asked to join a Google Classroom and start accruing hours.
