# Lockdown Drill

The health and safety of all children at BCHS is extremely important. One of our responsibilities is to run an annual lockdown drill which will be on Monday, December 11. The purpose of this drill is to practise how to protect everyone from harm when a danger is present inside the school. Students will review what to do, including "Safe, Silent & Serious", with their teachers in advance.

We recognise that the word "lockdown" raises questions and concerns. We invite parents to have a conversation at home with their child to be proactive. Teachers will certainly have these conversations at school too.

While incidents requiring an emergency response in our school are very, very low, "lockdown" drills are a part of our emergency response practices, just like fire drills. In this way, we hope everyone will feel more confident, less anxious, and better able to cope knowing there is a plan and procedure for this type of situation.

# Suicide Awareness, Intervention, and Support Presentations

The mental health and well-being of our students are also very important to us. While many people look forward to the holidays and the festive season, some struggle with their mental health. Coupled with the long dark days of winter it is vital for everyone to know who to turn to for support if thoughts of self-harm or suicide occur, or if they become aware that a friend needs support. On Thursday, December 14, Shannon Fountain from the Town of Banff will deliver presentations to each grade to raise awareness amongst our students about the support available online, by phone, and within our town.
