Student Timetables 2024-2025

A reminder that students now have a paper copy of their timetable for 2024-2025. Please go through this with your child and make an appointment at the main office if there are any requested changes. Please note that **June 14, 2024** is the last day to make changes - **changes will not be made in the fall**, except for Grade 12s.

Academic Notes

Diploma exams this week are English Language Arts 30-1 and 30-2 Part A on Tuesday and Social Studies 30-1 and 30-2 Part A on Wednesday. Grade 9s have their next **Provincial Assessment Tests (PAT)** in English Language Arts on Wednesday and Math Part A on

Thursday. Exams start at 9 am but for **this week all students should arrive by 8:30 am**. Students **must** return to their regular classes after completing their exam.

Starting on June 17, students can arrive for their exams at 8:45 am and they are not expected to be in school if they do not have an exam to write. Diploma exams dates cannot be changed so students who miss their exam will have to take the exam in August at an alternative location. If students are absent from school exams or PATs we can arrange an alternative sitting. Please let the school office know prior to 8.30 am if a student will be absent for an exam.

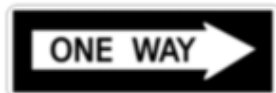
The **exam timetable** is available on our website and displayed around the school for students.

- If you are **applying for post-secondary scholarships**, use a personal email account, not your CRPS email.
- You will need to move your data **before** you leave BCHS.
- Google has tools to help you including:
 - **Download** – If there are only a few things you want to keep, including items shared with you, [download](#) a copy of individual files or folders.
 - **Forward important emails** to another personal email account. [Learn more](#).
 - **Transfer your content** – copy your Drive and Email files to a personal Google account. [Learn more](#).
 - **Archive/Takeout** - download a copy of items owned by you in all G Suite services into one zip file. [Learn more](#).
