Exam Week: June 17 - June 26

Starting on June 17, students may arrive at 8:45 am when they have a scheduled exam. If students do not have an exam scheduled, they are not expected to be in school. Students may prearrange a time to meet with teachers for additional support or exam prep, but they shouldn't drop in as teachers will be supervising exams.

Diploma exam dates **cannot be changed** so students who miss the exam or arrive more than an hour late will have to take the exam in August at an alternative location. If students are absent from **Grade 9 PATs** we can only arrange an alternative date until **Friday, June 21**. For school exams, we can arrange an alternative date until Wednesday, June 26. **Please let the school office know prior to 8.30 am if a student will be absent for an exam.** Students should come prepared with pens, pencils, calculators, and anything else they have been advised to bring by their teachers.

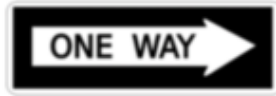

- If you are **applying for post-secondary scholarships**, use a personal email account, not your CRPS email.
- You will need to move your data **before** you leave BCHS.
- Google has tools to help you including:
 - **Download** – If there are only a few things you want to keep, including items shared with you, [download](#) a copy of individual files or folders.
 - **Forward important emails** to another personal email account. [Learn more](#).
 - **Transfer your content** – copy your Drive and Email files to a personal Google account. [Learn more](#).
 - **Archive/Takeout** - download a copy of items owned by you in all G Suite services into one zip file. [Learn more](#).
