# **Grade 9 Parents Information Meeting on Outcomes Based Assessment**

All Grade 9 parents are invited to attend an important information session on **Wednesday**, **September 11th** at **7pm** in the gym. This session will provide parents with a clear explanation of the method used in CRPS high schools this year to assess student learning in Grade 9 and how parents can follow their child's progress through PowerSchool.

# **Teacher Support**

Assignment completion is a work habit and skill that we hope all students develop as they pass through high school. However, some students need a little more support with being independent in their work habits. Teacher support sessions run over lunchtime on **Tuesdays**, **Wednesdays**, and **Thursdays**. These sessions are for students who do not complete assignments by deadlines or who miss a test due to an absence. Parents will be informed by the teacher that the student has missed a deadline and they will be required to attend a homework support session in the library at lunchtime. Students will need to bring their lunch with them.

## Grade 12 Parents and Students Information Session - Advance Notice

There will be an information meeting on graduation and post-secondary planning on **Monday**, **September 16th** at **7pm** in the gym. This session will provide parents and students with information and advice on how the pathway to graduation in June 2025 works, tips on how to apply for post-secondary education and scholarships, and details about our school's Graduation Ceremony.

# **Annual Demographic Update**

Parents and guardians have now received notification that the annual demographic information about their child needs to be updated. Please fill it out and submit it as soon as possible. The school needs to have accurate information on home addresses, guardianship, emergency contacts, and medical alerts.

The form also asks for walking field trip consent: this question refers to times when a class is going to visit somewhere in the Town of Banff. Some examples are: a PE class getting ready for the annual Turkey Trot run, a Humanities class visiting the cemetery near Remembrance Day, or a Foods class buying groceries for their next lab. If consent is not provided, then the student will remain in school without their class. We hope that all students can take part in these low-risk off site activities.
